This program provides students with opportunities to achieve success and reach their potential in the game of Basketball. The College provides elite level teaching and learning programs that allow each student to improve in all aspects of the game.

Woodvale basketball teams consistently perform outstandingly at both State and National levels.

In this program students are given the opportunity to participate in Basketball camps, Champion Schools Competitions, strength and conditioning development, coaching course officiating course, specialised training by guest coaches and more.

The Course

The aim of the program is to further develop skills, attitudes and knowledge in students with high level basketball ability that will enable them to compete successfully in basketball at the highest levels.

- Develop individual skills
- Develop team skills
- Develop skills in refereeing, coaching and statistical analysis
- Provide opportunity to participate in state, national and international competitions
- Conduct basketball related fitness testing and develop programs to improve individual fitness levels
- Video analysis of individual skill performance and team structures
- Understand the physiological and skill requirements for basketball at an elite level
- Undertake Sports Medicine Australia training programs including first aid and injury prevention and management
- Provide information relating to diet and nutrition.

Students in this program do not attend general Physical Education classes in Years 7 & 8.

Applications for Year 7 in 2025

Applications for our Year 7 in 2025 Specialist Basketball Program have closed. There is a waitlist for the Principal to review applications for these programs.

If you would like to apply for this waitlist please fill in the application documents, print and hand them into our Front Office staff (all documentation must be handed in during this time). Please be aware that applications will not be reviewed until Term 3 and will depend on availability in our timetable.

Please note you will only receive correspondence from the College if your application has been reviewed.

Selection

Students are ranked in the first instance using evidence as demonstrated through:

- Player profile reports provided
- Academic reports
- Social, behavioural progress as outlined by the Attitude/Behaviour/Effort domains and report comments

1. Selected students are invited to trial. A second trial may be required.
2. Offers are made after the trial.
3. Students are required to maintain high standards across all domains of College life to maintain their placement in their specialist program.

Expectations

Students may only enrol in the Basketball or Music specialist program. They can enrol in Basketball and the Academic Extension and Enrichment Program. Students accepting a place in the basketball program are expected to continue to study basketball to the end of Year 9 as a minimum.

Failure to honour the conditions of the agreement, may result in the student being removed from the program.
